Hokie Passport Services sets up the "Little Tent on the Prairie"

A special shout-out to the HPS team for a creative solution to working with students on ID cards. During Move-In, the team established a tented space on the Dietrick Prairie on Washington Street to validate ID cards in a safe, distanced manner. Dubbed the "Little Tent on the Prairie," this space (along with the Student Service Building operation) was instrumental in HPS validating **4,953** ID cards that were mailed out earlier in the summer.

This was also the first year in which students remotely submitted photos for their ID cards, and in total HPS produced **7,574** ID cards for the entire student population.
