### Vaccination Status Self-Reporting Form due August 15

All employees are encouraged to receive a COVID-19 vaccine. Those who do are required to register their vaccination information with the university **after receiving their final dose**. Employees who register their status and upload proof of vaccination will be exempt from surveillance testing during the 2021-2022 academic year.

### New telework and alternate work schedule agreements forms site coming soon

A new site for flexible work arrangement agreements, including telework and alternate work schedules, will launch at the end of July.

To prepare for the switch to the new system, as of July 1, the old telework and alternate work schedule web forms are no longer available. All existing agreements will be migrated from the old forms to the new forms. Between now and the late July launch of the new form site, no new agreements can be created and no existing agreements will be able to be updated/renewed.

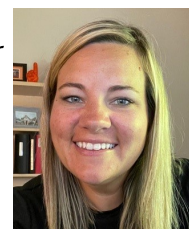
