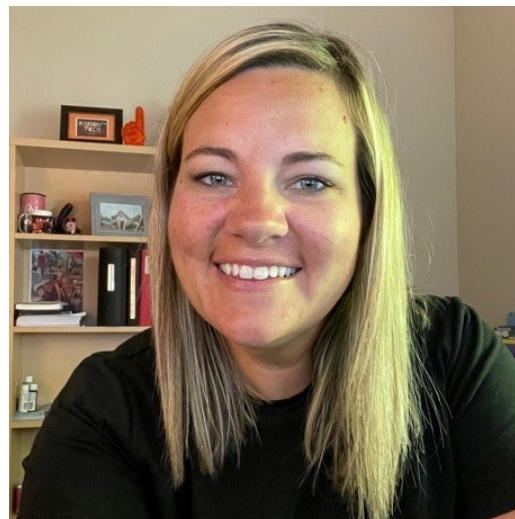


# EMPLOYEE SPOTLIGHT AMANDA MARCUM
